The 1978 Survey lists this as the Lasker House. "The Lasker family is well known in financial circles." However, by the official nomination to the National Register in 1984, the house is known as the Vanetten House. From the national register nomination and the 1978 Quapaw Quarter Architectural – Historic inventory card.<sup>1</sup>

This building was nominated with the Charles Thompson multiple property submission which is a thematic group listing of the National Register of Historic Places that consists of related properties that share a common theme and can be submitted as a group.
