“Built in 1908, the cottages were the rental property of Phillip R. Van Frank. They are the only existing historic houses associated with this civil engineer, who was instrumental in the improvement of Arkansas’ rivers.¹

“In 1914 he sold the property to another man of German ancestry, Gustave Kleinschmidt, a saloon keeper who also lived within the district.²
