“Judging from the Real Estate Tax records of Pulaski County, Runyun built his home in 1901 and took residence the following year. Joseph P. Runyun would be home a prominent citizen in Little Rock, establishing a respectable practice and. In 1915, becoming the sole Owners of Saint Luke’s Hospital.”<sup>1</sup>
